

Origami Frog

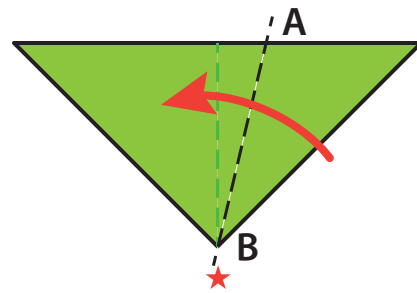
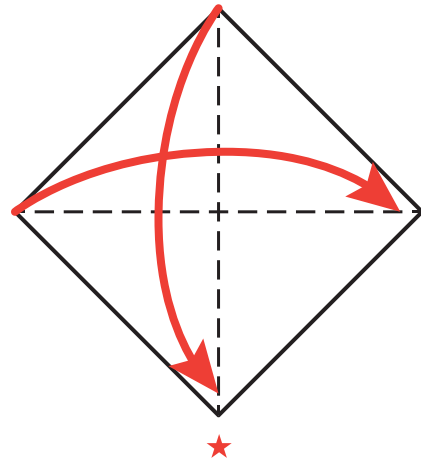
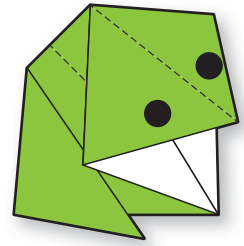

Instructions

1. Start with a square piece of paper. (All sides should be equal, and all angles should be right angles.) Make sure the white side of the paper is up.

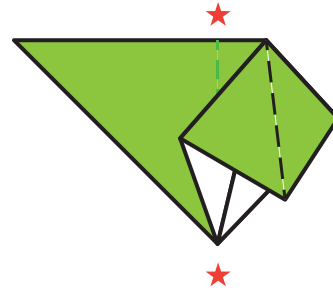
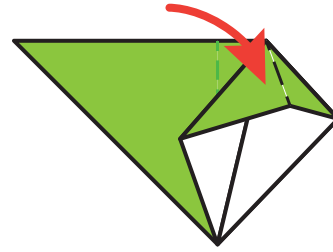
Carefully fold the square in half from left to right. Then unfold. Carefully fold the square in half from top to bottom. Do not unfold this time. The shape is now a triangle.

2. Fold the right side of the triangle back and to the left along a line from A to B. Then unfold. Along the same crease, fold the right side forward and to the left. This time, unfold it only halfway.

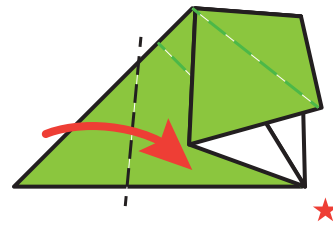


Origami Frog (cont.)

3. With your finger, open the right side of the triangle to make a pocket. Gently flatten the pocket from top to bottom. This is the frog's head.



4. Fold the left side of the triangle forward and to the right. This is the frog's back leg.



5. Draw some eyes.

Success—you've folded a frog!
